fully immunized PROGRAM EVALUATION

- 81% of children received a timely screen for developmental delays using a validated parent-completed tool. [Ages & Stages Questionnaire]
- of participants have learned to anticipate their child's developmental changes after two years of service.
- of parents provide loving responses to child's cues. Parent praised child, helps them regulate well, child shows reciprocal connections after two years of service.
- 81% of participants reported that during a typical week a family member read, told stories, and/or sang songs with their child daily.


