




Read & Stay Active

Families attending Play & Learn in January have been enjoying the story and activities that are prepared for A Day in the Snow, by Eric Carle.

Many of us have read one of the many books written or illustrated by Eric Carle. One of his most popular is *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*. In *A Day in the Snow*, you and your child can go on an adventure with *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* through the pages to explore the winter wonderland outside. On each page, *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* makes an appearance. This story is an opportunity to find *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* and explore wildlife through the many animals that appear. The vibrant colors throughout contrast on the white snow, engaging you and your littles to find everything on each page. After taking the adventure through the pages, take the adventure outside.
