WELCOME BABY

FRCSCV meets with families who have just delivered a baby in five local hospitals (Amery, Osceola, St. Croix Health, Westfields, Western Wisconsin Health).

A FRCSCV Parent Educator introduces them to the Period of Purple Crying, FRCSCV programs and services and answers any parenting questions the family may have.



HOME VISITING

Participants will receive visits from a Parent Educator twice a month where they are available to answer questions, provide parent-child education, and resources during visits.

Parents As Teachers Home Visiting is a program using evidence-based curriculum.

The FRCSCV building is approximately 100 years old and approximately 6,000 square feet in size.


Included in Renovation Project

- Replace existing façade, including new exterior finishes
- Reconfigure existing floor plan to improve functionality:
 - o (1) Conference Room
 - (3) Meeting rooms 2 Consult, 1 Home Visit
 - (17) Workstations 10 Existing, 7 New
 - Update furniture, fixtures & equipment
 - o (3) offices

- Interior framing, drywall, painting, doors, glass & glazing, ceiling tiles will be replaced. Subfloor will be built in some areas and a combination of LVP flooring and carpeting will be installed.
- Improve roof drainage and new awning on alley-side
- Pave alley-side parking area
- · Installation of secure entry system





Financial Goals

With your support, FRCSCV will be improving the building at 857 Main Street in Baldwin. The plan includes new flooring, replacing the wood floor in the program room with softer carpet tiles for improved functionality when working with children in the space, wall repair, painting, doors, glass & glazing and replacing ceiling tiles. This also gives staff the opportunity to utilize the back of the building with improved roof drainage and access to parking at the rear of the office.



Included are additional workstations to accommodate anticipated growth, two consult rooms and one home visiting space where visits with families can be confidential, along with a new conference room.





The scope of the project will include a new and improved façade, providing less confusion, ease of access for guests and a more aesthetically pleasing store front for Main Street.

April

FRCSCV Properties, LLC Formed. Purchased building at 857 Main St., Baldwin, WI

September

FRCSCV Properties, LLC hires architect Studio EA to develop schematic design for renovation to address needs.

2023

January

FRCSCV, Properties LLC interviews Construction Manager candidates. Hires Kraus-Anderson.
Village of Baldwin submits Community Development Investment Grant on behalf of FRCSCV Properties, LLC AND accepts FRCSCV application for Façade Grant.

February/March

Submit grant applications. Development Committee launches quiet fundraising campaign.

April/May

Obtained building permit approvals. Bank orders appraisal. Community fundraising continues.

June/July

Execute WEDC contract and Loan Agreement with Bremer Bank. Fundraising continues. Groundbreaking and launch public Capital Campaign.

August-November

Construction underway, fundraising continues.

December
