Home Visiting is a no-cost program for families with children prenatal to kindergarten entry. Enrolled participants will receive home visits from a parent educator twice a month. Parent Educators are available to answer your questions, provide parent-child education & resources during visits.

Why you should participate

- Learn about parent/child behaviors
- Learn about your child's development such as:
 - Brain Development
 - Attachment
 - Transitions & Routines

Learn about developmental milestones such as sleeping, sitting, walking and talking too.

This visit may be a one-time visit until we meet you again at Welcome Baby or if you enroll in the Parents as Teachers Home Visiting program.

A FRCSVCV Parent Educator will schedule a visit with you in the hospital after the birth of your baby. The Parent Educator offers support, resources and provides parenting information on Period of Purple Crying.

An FRCSVCV Parent Educator will also share information on Baby & Me classes and other programs and services.

Baby & Me

FRCSVCV is here to help with your child's developmental milestones such as:

- Rolling
- Sitting Up, Crawling, Standing, Walking
- Sleep
- Feelings
- Smiling
- Teething
- Grabbing
- Talking
- Eating Solid Foods

FRCSVCV also helps with:

- Breastfeeding
- Managing Parenting Stressors

These milestones are important as they help families know children are developing skills at an appropriate pace.
